The ready-to-complete Will template. England & Wales.

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How to use this document

This is your actual Will. Everything you personally need to complete is highlighted in yellow. Work through it in order:

1. Type your own details into every yellow-highlighted field, replacing the guidance text inside it.
2. Delete any clause marked (optional) that does not apply to you, for example guardians if you have no children under 18.
3. When you have finished, remove the yellow highlighting (select all, then clear highlighting) so the finished Will looks clean and formal.
4. Print it single-sided on good-quality paper. Do not staple or attach anything to it.
5. Sign it with two adult witnesses present at the same time, following the signing steps on the last page. A Will is only legally valid once it is signed and witnessed correctly.

Your witnesses must not be people who inherit under this Will, nor married to anyone who does. If they are, they lose their gift.

Declaration and revocation 1.

This is the last Will of me, [your full name] of [your full address], made on [date, e.g. 14 August 2026].

I revoke all earlier Wills and codicils.

Appointment of executors 2.

Executors are the people who carry out your Will. Name one or two, and ideally a substitute.

I appoint [first executor: full name and address] and [second executor: full name and address] to be the executors of this my Will.

If either of them is unable or unwilling to act, I appoint [substitute executor: full name and address] in their place.
